Online gambling is a growing activity in the world. Unlike local gambling outlets, New Zealand has no laws that protect us from gambling products created overseas and available to us online.

There is no guarantee that you will get your money out once you have put it in, there is no guarantee that you are playing with a real person and the algorithms are designed for the site owners to make a profit. Although some sites offer the ability to self exclude from the gambling site, these are not always honoured and do not prevent push notifications to your devices.
